



Maths

All children will continue to be taught number discretely during their 1.1 sessions

Maths topic area: Measurement

sorting, matching, counting and measuring objects.



Life skills:

Children will be learning how to correctly brush their teeth and comb their hair.

Motor movement:

Children will have daily motor movements where they get to use the therapy balls and trampoline.

Sensory room:

After lunch, the children will have a relaxation session in the sensory room. Children will have weekly sensory play. This will involve children engaging in messy water, sand and dried foods.

TACPAC:

This is a sensory communication session using touch and music.

Attention Autism

This session aims to develop natural and spontaneous communication.

Topic focus: Animals

Spring 1: Children will learn about animals in a variety of habitats including sea life, farm, jungle and zoo.

Writing and fine motor



All children will work on their individual writing skills during their 1.1 session, this could range from mark making and letter formation to name recognition and writing.

Fine motor:

- Threading
- Handwriting practice
- Cutting
- Developing their pincer and tripod grip

Reading



Children will learn their phonics through the 'Jolly Phonics' scheme daily.

They will be read to by an adult daily to work on their reading targets.

Story time:

Children will have a book they read each week and learn about the sequence, characters and settings. This will be linked to their topics.

Speech and language:



Children will work on their individual speech and language targets set by the therapist throughout the day, this will include using PECS and talk buttons. They will also have a 20-minute speech and language session.
