Maths

All children will continue to be taught number discretely during their 1.1 sessions.

Maths topic area: Measurement

comparing, and measuring lengths and heights



Life skills:

Children will be learning how to correctly brush their teeth and comb their hair

Motor movement:

Children will have daily motor movements where they get to use the therapy balls and trampoline!

Sensory room:

After lunch, the children will have a

relaxation session in the sensory room. Children will have weekly sensory play. This will involve children engaging in messy, water, sand and dried foods.

TACPAC:

This is a sensory communication session using touch and music.


Attention Autism

All children will work on their individual writing skills during their 1.1 session, this could range from letter formation to recognising and writing CVC words.
