



Maths

All children will continue to be taught number discretely during their 1.1 sessions.

Maths topic area: Measurement and money



Spring 2: comparing, and measuring capacity (weight and volume) and recognising the value of coins.

Life skills:

Children will continue to brush their teeth and their hair. They will start to learn how to make their beds.

Motor movement:

Children will have daily motor movements where they get to use the therapy balls and trampoline!

Sensory room:

After lunch, the children will have a relaxation session in the sensory room. Children will have weekly sensory play. This will involve children engaging in messy, water, sand and dried foods.

TACPAC:

This is a sensory communication session using touch and music.

Attention Autism

This session aims to develop natural and spontaneous communication. There will be a focus on turn-taking during these sessions.

Topic focus: Spring

Spring 2: Children will focus on growing and change from the perspective of animal life cycles. They will also learn about the season of Spring.

Writing and fine motor



All children will work on their individual writing skills during their 1.1 session, this could range from letter formation to recognising and writing CVC words.

Children will use their colourful semantics knowledge to write simple sentences.

Fine motor:

- Threading
- Handwriting practice
- Cutting
- Developing their pincer and tripod grip

Reading



Children will learn their phonics through the 'Jolly Phonics' scheme daily.

They will be read to by an adult daily to work on their reading targets.

Story time:

Children will have a book they read each week and learn about the sequence, characters and settings. This will be linked to their topics.
