



Maths

All children will continue to be taught number discretely during their 1.1 sessions.

Maths topic area: Money

Children will be learning to recognise and exchange coins for items.



Life skills:

Children will learn how to make their beds, fold laundry and explore using the washing machine.

Motor movement:

Children will have daily motor movements where they get to use the therapy balls and trampoline!

Sensory room:

After lunch, the children will have a relaxation session in the sensory room. Children will have weekly sensory play. This will involve children engaging in messy, water, sand and dried foods.

TACPAC:

This is a sensory communication session using touch and music.

Attention Autism

This session aims to develop natural and spontaneous communication. There will be a focus on turn-taking during these sessions.

Topic focus: Colours and Shapes

Summer 1: Children will explore colours and colour mixing. They will be identifying and recognising 2D shapes.

Writing and fine motor



All children will work on their individual writing skills during their 1.1 session, this could range from mark making and letter formation to writing initial sounds and CVC words.

Fine motor:

- Threading
- Handwriting practice
- Cutting
- Developing their pincer and tripod grip

Reading



Children will learn their phonics through the 'Jolly Phonics' scheme daily. They will be read to by an adult daily to work on their reading targets.

Story time:

Children will have a book they read each week and learn about the story sequence, characters and settings. This will be linked to their topic work. Below are some of the books we will be reading:

Speech and language:



Children will work on their individual speech and language targets set by the therapist throughout the day, this will include using PECS, core-board and colourful semantics. They will also have a daily 20-minute speech and language session.
