Redbridge Council is carrying out a public consultation on the introduction of School Streets at **Mayespark Primary School** to make the school journey safer and healthier for pupils.

Redbridge School Streets

- protect children from traffic at the school gate
- encourage more walking, cycling and scooting to school
- help reduce levels of air pollution around the school



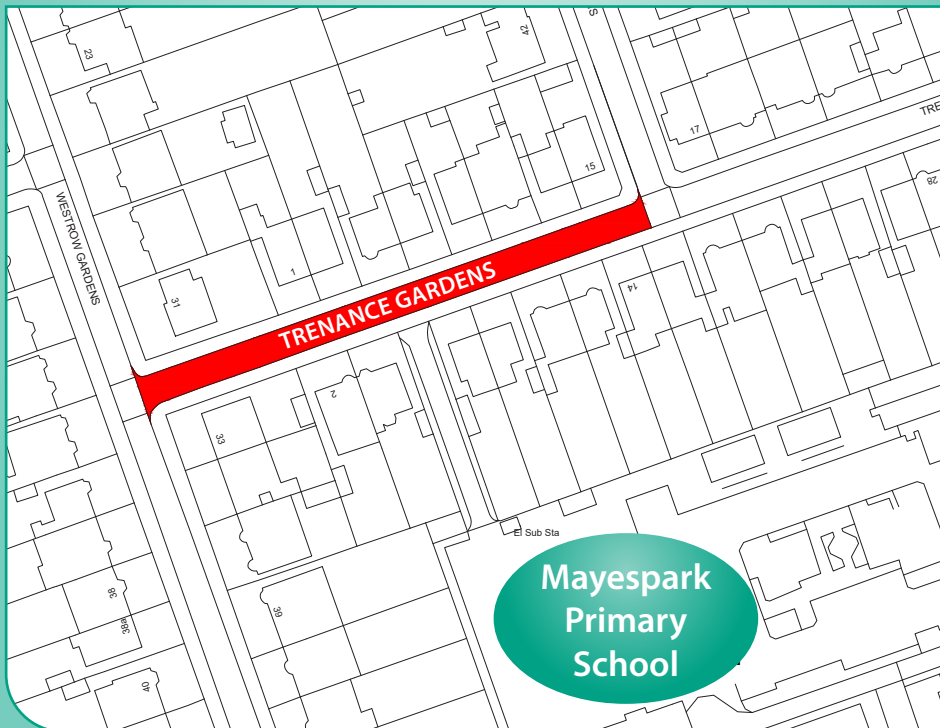
How does School Streets work?


Roads surrounding schools in the School Streets programme will be closed to vehicles at the start and end of the school day, during term time.

If the proposal is implemented then residents and businesses within the School Street zone can apply for a free vehicle exemption from the council.

Non-exempt vehicles entering the school streets zones when restrictions are in force will be identified by traffic enforcement cameras, and issued with a fine.

The proposed timings of the restrictions are:

Morning 8am - 9.15am

Afternoon 2.30pm - 4pm
