Dear Parents / Carers,

Our planned trip for this half term as had to be cancelled due to the polling day on 4<sup>th</sup> July 2024. We were due to visit the Science Museum to consolidate our learning in Science lessons about forces and magnets and to research our new topic, light and dark. We were unable to book a new date at this venue due to it being fully booked. The Science Museum is a fantastic resource so if you get a chance, please take your child at a weekend or in the summer holidays. It is free to enter and there is so much to see and do.

Our current geography topic is all about Rivers. Children will be learning to name and locate counties and cities in the UK, geographical regions and key topographical features. To aid their learning we have been very lucky to organise a trip to Tower Bridge, in London, which will be an extremely valuable experience for the children.

**All Year 3 classes will be visiting Tower Bridge on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> July 2024.**

Children will need to be in school by **8.40am** as we will leave promptly and will be back at school by **3.15pm**. All pupils will need a healthy packed lunch, which contains **NO NUTS** or fizzy drinks. Please select below, if you would like school to provide lunch for your child.

Children will be required to wear school uniform and any rain wear if required. They will also need to wear comfortable shoes.

To ensure that the children have a safe trip, we would like some parents or carers to accompany us and take responsibility for a small group of children. If you are selected to support us and then withdraw, we will have to **cancel the visit for the children without refunds** as a result of the school having limited time to find a replacement. Due to financial constraints on the school budget, we now do not have enough school staff to use for school visits, so please ensure you are definitely available before volunteering.

The visit will cost **£3.50 per child** and children are **not allowed** to take any spending money. All payments will need to be made via **PARENTPAY**.
