Your views!

Thank you to those of you who completed the recent parent survey. The results have been benchmarked against similar schools and we are pleased with the results!

- 86% of you said that your child has either good or very good experience at school, compared with 85% in schools like ours.
- 79% said poor behavior is dealt with well, compared with 64% in schools like ours
- 70% said the school deals with bullying effectively compared with 54% in schools like ours.
- 96% said parents evening gives you a good sense of how your child is doing, compared to 88% in schools like ours.
