Dear Parents / Carers,

For geography children have been looking at different continents and the memorable landmarks within them. Children are also learning about free standing structures in our DT unit 'Bridges'. To aid their learning we have organised a visit to The London Eye, which will be an extremely valuable experience for the children. Children will have the opportunity to travel across a bridge and see how well free-standing structures such as the London Eye and the Golden Jubilee bridge work in person, prior to later creating their own structures in class.

All Year 2 classes will be visiting The London Eye on Tuesday 1st February 2022.

We will be leaving school at **9:15 am** and returning at approximately **2.30pm**. Children must come to school by 9.00am for registration and will be ready to collect at 3:15pm as usual. Children will need to take a packed lunch with them in a rucksack labelled with their name. **All year 2 children are entitled to a free packed lunch from school but we must know in advance. Please indicate below if you would like a packed lunch to be provided.** If you are providing your child with a packed lunch, please ensure it does not contain any products containing nuts or any fizzy drinks. Children will be required to wear school uniform and any rain wear if required. They will also need to wear comfortable shoes.

We will be travelling by public transport and all government guidelines will be followed when using public transport and public spaces. Adults will all wear face masks and children will be allowed to wear face masks if they wish to. Hands will be washed or sanitised when and where possible. The London Eye will take responsibility to ensure that the visit is Covid-19 safe once we are inside the pods.

To ensure that the children have a safe trip, we would like some parents or carers to accompany us and take responsibility for a small group of children. If you are selected to support us and then withdraw, we will have to **cancel the visit for the children without refunds** as a result of the school having limited time to find a replacement. Due to financial constraints on the school budget, we now do not have enough school staff to use for school visits, so please ensure you are definitely available before volunteering.

The visit will cost **£13 per child** and children are **not allowed** to take any spending money. All payments will need to be made via **PARENTPAY**. **Please fill out the consent form below and return it to the class teacher as soon as possible before**
